

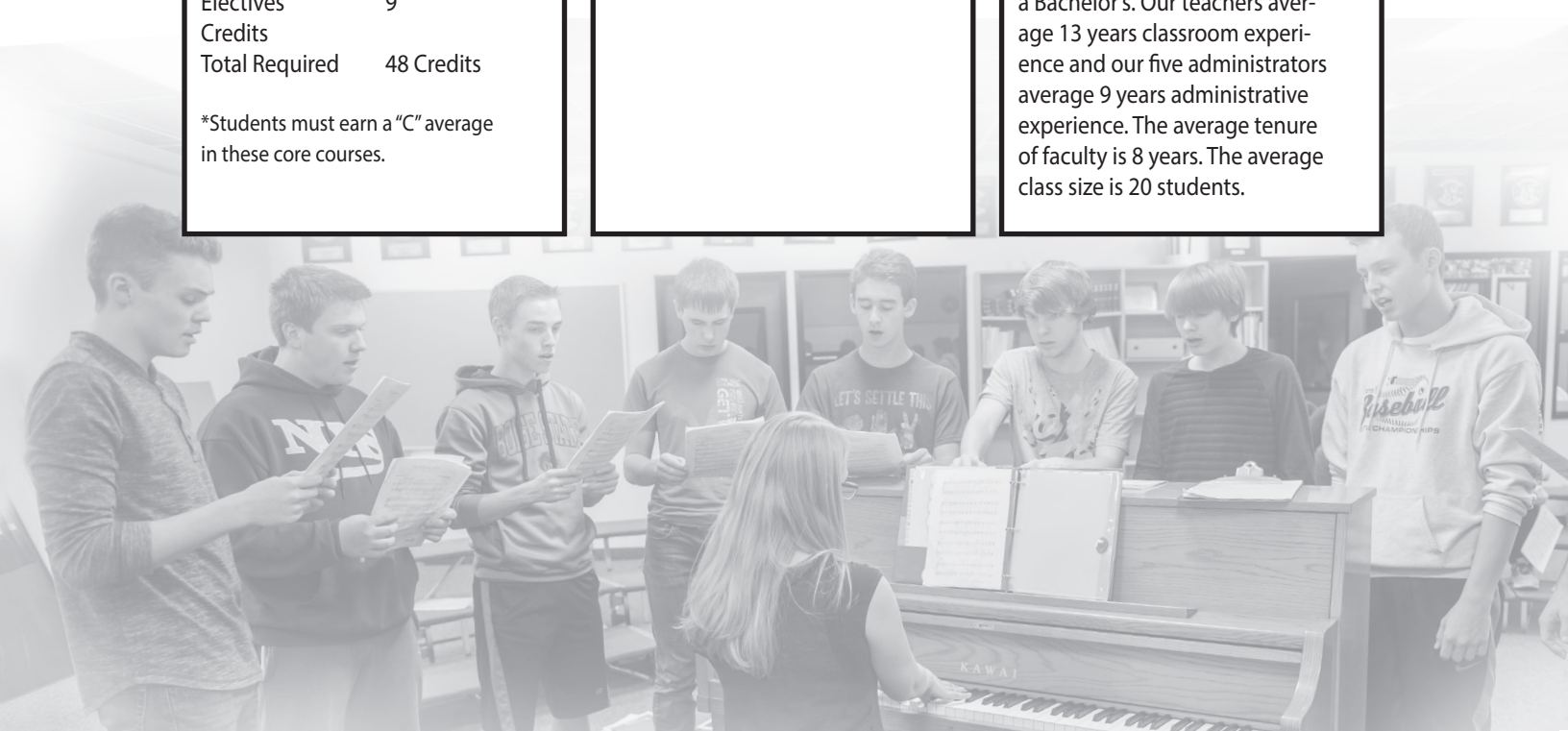
ACADEMIC PROFILE AND CURRICULUM

Curriculum • Academic Programs

Elementary (PreK - 5th Grades)

A variety of curriculum is used to create a Biblical worldview, comprehensive high academic program including but not limited to Abeka, BJU (Bob Jones University), McGraw Hill and Spalding. Technology plays an integral part of our school day with an updated computer lab servicing Kindergarten through Fifth grade, along with chromebooks in each classroom. Fifth grade students are required to do one hour of community service each quarter. This service will be part of their Bible grade. Although NCS families use a variety of versions of scripture, our Bible curriculum and special programs follow the NIV version.

Middle School (6th - 8th Grades)

Middle School represent the transition between the self-contained classroom of the elementary school and the independence within the high school. Nampa Christian Middle School promotes a climate of caring and community between students and teachers, while establishing a partnership between home and school. English, science, history, physical education, and Bible, as well as a variety of electives, balance academic goals and priorities to ensure that the school day is a blend of opportunities to develop students' minds, hearts, dispositions, talents and bodies.

High School (9th - 12 Grades)

Beginning in the 9th grade, we encourage students to consider their next step to higher education with regular opportunities to meet with College representatives at the school and concurrent credit offerings with local universities to advance a student's pace at the collegiate level prior to entering college and enrich our student's educational opportunities. Whether the student's interests are athletics, drama, singing in the choir, or playing an instrument in the band, Nampa Christian High School provides a wide variety of opportunities with a sharp focus on scriptural principles.

Curriculum at the high school level challenges students with a mixture of scripturally based curriculum and secular.

Our goal is use our curriculum to enhance our instruction and to integrate Biblical principles into each of our lessons.
