MINIMUM IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ENTRY

Children born after September 1, 1999, through September 1, 2005, must have a minimum of:

- 5 doses of Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP)
- 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- 3 doses of Polio
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B

Children born after September 1, 2005, must have a minimum of:

- 5 doses of Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP)
- 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- 4 doses of Polio
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B
- 2 doses of Varicella (Chickenpox)
- 2 doses of Hepatitis A

7th GRADE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Children admitted to 7th grade must meet the following minimum immunization requirements in addition to school entry requirements:

- 1 dose of Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP)
- 1 dose of Meningococcal
- 4. Signed Statement of Faith Form
- 5. Non-refundable \$50 application & evaluation fee due at time of application.

After your application and supporting documents have been received, we will contact you to schedule an interview and screening/placement test. A \$15 testing fee will be collected at the time of the interview.
